- Read and interpret blueprints, drawings, specifications and work orders to determine installation and service requirements.
- Measure and lay out reference points for the installation of heating, ventilation, refrigeration and air conditioning equipment.
- Install heating, ventilation, air conditioning, refrigeration and heat pump systems and associated components.
- Install and service compressors, condensers, evaporators, controls, motors, fans, pumps and other HVAC and refrigeration components.
- Measure, cut, assemble and connect piping and tubing using appropriate mechanical joining, soldering and brazing methods.

- Start up heating, refrigeration and air conditioning systems and test systems for proper operation.
- Test piping and system components for leaks using appropriate testing equipment and procedures.
- Charge, recover and handle refrigerants in accordance with applicable environmental and safety requirements.
- Troubleshoot heating, ventilation, air conditioning, heat pump and refrigeration systems to identify faults and determine required repairs.
- Test electrical and electronic components and controls associated with HVAC and refrigeration equipment.
- Repair or replace defective mechanical, electrical and refrigeration components.
- Adjust and calibrate controls, thermostats and other system components to ensure safe and efficient operation.
- Perform scheduled preventive maintenance and routine servicing of heating, refrigeration and air conditioning equipment.
- Maintain service records and document equipment condition, maintenance and repairs performed.
